BRIGID COLVIN of Loxahatchee, FL, violated Chapter 4, GR410-411 of this Federation in that, in connection with the 2014 USHJA International Hunter Derby Championship Horse Show held on August 14-16, 2014, she, as trainer, exhibited the horse **INCLUSIVE** on or about August 15, 2014, in the Classic Hunter Round after it had been administered and/or it contained in its body gamma-aminobutyric acid in excess of normal physiologic levels; and gamma-aminobutyric acid in excess of normal physiologic levels was detected in the blood sample.
