AGREED PERMANENT INJUNCTION

Upon agreement of the parties, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. That from the date of this Order until February 26, 2005, the Plaintiff is hereby enjoined and restrained from appearing in any capacity, including exhibitor, participant or spectator, on those portions of the grounds of any property or other facility that are set aside for the conduct of all equestrian competitions recognized by the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc., at any time during such days as those competitions are being conducted.
2. That as of February 26, 2005, so long as the Plaintiff has not been found to have breached the terms and conditions of this Agreed Permanent Injunction and the Mutual Release and Settlement Agreement entered on June 30, 2004, this permanent injunction shall be dissolved and this action will then be dismissed, with prejudice, upon an agreed order of

dismissal by the parties. It is further agreed that said parties shall bear their own costs and attorney fees.

3. This Court will retain jurisdiction over this case during the pendency of this permanent injunction.

4. This agreed permanent injunction supersedes the preliminary injunction entered on April 26, 2004.
