
Re: USEF v. Colvin, Rivetts and Parker

Dear Julie:

On behalf of the Federation's Drugs and Medications Program (the "Federation"), I submit this response to the Respondents' requests for an investigation under Chapter 6, GR 617 and/or a dismissal or Plea Agreement.

A review of the submissions by the Respondents indicates that there is a fundamental dispute as to the identity of the trainer or trainers of INCLUSIVE in this case. As you know, the Hearing Committee is not limited to the person whose name appears on the Entry Form. In this case, Mr. Rivetts is listed on the Entry Form as the trainer and Ms. Colvin is listed as the trainer on the Sample Identification Card. They have provided information in their submissions that does not resolve the issue. Accordingly, it is imperative that this matter be scheduled for a hearing at which the testimony of all the parties and their witnesses can resolve the issue. The Charge should not be dismissed against Ms. Colvin and this matter needs to be heard by the Hearing Committee.
