ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Upon reading the attached Verified Petition, dated August 28, 2015, the Affirmation of Courtney Devon Taylor dated August 28, 2015, the Memorandum of Law in Support of the Motion for a Stay Pursuant to CPLR §7805, Notice of Compliance with 22 N.Y.C.R.R. §202.7(f), and upon all of the papers and proceedings heretofore had herein, let the Respondent show cause before this Court, at an IAS Part, in Room ¹⁰² at the courthouse located at ~~60 Centre~~ ^{71 THOMAS} Street, New York, New York 10007, on the ^{17th} day of September, 2015 at 9:30 a.m./p.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, why an order should not be made and entered herein, pursuant to CPLR §7805, (1) granting a stay of enforcement of Respondent's determination suspending Petitioner BRIGID COLVIN, and its exclusion of Petitioner BRIGID COLVIN from its Licensed Competitions and competition grounds; and (2) granting petitioner the relief demanded in the Verified Petition, including a stay of the

enforcement of all USEF penalties and the suspension, and a determination that the USEF decision was arbitrary and capricious, an abuse of discretion and not supported by substantial evidence, together with such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.

PENDING THE HEARING OF THE MOTION AND PETITION, it is ordered that the suspension and exclusion of Petitioner BRIGID COLVIN is temporarily stayed in all respects; and it is

September 11, 2015, and it is further

ORDERED that reply, if any, shall be served by ECF on Respondent's counsel on or before September 16, 2015.
